We are currently looking for a Network Coordinator to join our growing team. This is an exciting opportunity to help build an ambitious movement to phase out oil and gas extraction in the UK.

The Role

As Network Coordinator, you will support a diverse network of organisations, constituencies and affected communities who are working towards shared goals. You will hold the central coordinating function across multiple networks and in many cases serve as the first point of contact between Uplift and partner organisations. You will also help partner organisations and Uplift in identifying and meeting various campaign, communications and research needs of partners.

Working closely with the Head of Campaigns and Communications on overall coalition management and strategy, you will help us to define how we can best create maximum, sustainable impact.

Core responsibilities will include:

- Building relationships and partnerships with new constituencies, organisations, and affected communities.
- Coordinating various formal and informal coalitions dedicated to phasing out fossil fuels and supporting a just transition in the UK
- Facilitating meetings and leading and tracking strategy-setting processes with groups of diverse partners and stakeholders, in collaboration with the Uplift team



- Developing campaign and communications resources in collaboration with key partners and networks.
- Supporting the execution of campaign and communication strategies and tactics in collaboration with key partners.
- When possible, providing campaign advice to partners, advocates and community groups working towards the same goals.
- Working with the rest of the Uplift team to provide communications, campaign and research support to core partners.

About You

Our ideal candidate will have:

- Significant experience in a similar or related role.
- A track record of guiding and supporting effective campaigning coalitions
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills, including an ability to quickly build trust with partners and colleagues and address and resolve conflicts
- Extensive professional networks within the UK.
- A deep commitment to building distributed and diverse leadership.
- Motivation, initiative, exceptionally high standards, a collaborative approach, and associated qualities needed to work in a dynamic organisation with an ambitious agenda.
- A strong commitment to Uplift's mission and core values of equity and climate justice.
