### About Us

Uplift is a campaigning and research organisation helping to move the UK towards a fossil fuel-free future and to support a just transition away from fossil fuel production.

We are currently looking for a Campaigns Organiser with a strong track record of campaigning, local organising or activist support to support our growing team. The Campaign Organiser will collaborate with Uplift's campaigns team, partners and activists to support the development and execution of powerful campaign and communication strategies for transitioning away from oil and gas extraction. They will also help to build the organisation's network of partners and activists.

Core responsibilities will include:

- Supporting the execution and development of campaign strategies and tactics in collaboration with local activists, key partners and the Campaigns team
- Building relationships and partnerships with new activists, constituencies and organisations
- Facilitating meetings and supporting strategy-setting and action planning processes with groups of diverse partners and stakeholders, in collaboration with the Uplift team
- Working with the rest of the Uplift team to provide communications, campaign and research support to core partners and activists
- Support in the planning and execution of a range of offline and online campaign tactics

- Coordinating with activists engaged in Uplift's campaigns, facilitating the delivery of support and training, and helping set pathways for sustained and meaningful engagement
- Supporting the development of campaign resources in collaboration with local activists, key partners and networks.
- Supporting individuals directly taking part in Uplift's existing and planned campaigns

The Campaign Organiser's working days will be agreed with Uplift's Head of Campaigns and Communications and invoices will be paid on a monthly basis.
